Anna Albers, aged 86, widow of Joseph Albers, died at 11:05 p. m. Wednesday in the home of her son Frank with whom she lived. Her death was attributed to a complication of diseases.

Funeral services will be held at 9 a. m. Saturday in St. Augustine's church. Requiem high mass will be sung by the Rev. William Meyer. Burial will be made in the church burial ground.

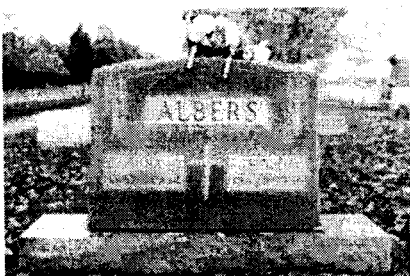
Mrs. Albers was a lifelong resident of this community. Her marriage to Mr. Albers took place in 1887. He preceded her in death, in 1936.

Survivors include two sons, Frank and Louis, seven grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren, and a sister, Miss Mary Bankemper, all of Minster. Mrs. Albers was a member of the St. Monica sodality of the church.
