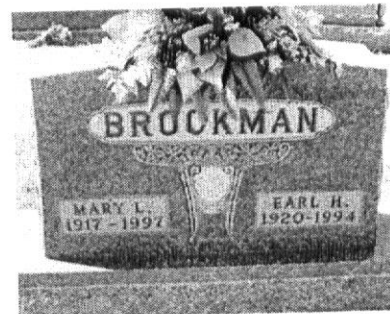

Earl H. Brockman, 74

NEW BREMEN — Earl Henry Brockman, 74, 8855 Brockman Road, died at 12:19 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 30, 1994, at Good Samaritan Hospital, Dayton, where he had been a patient since Monday.

He was born May 14, 1920, northwest of New Bremen to Benjamin and Evelyn (Rump) Brockman. On Jan. 2, 1945, he married Yvonne Scheer, who died Feb. 1, 1947. On March 22, 1961, he married Mary Musser, who survives.

He is also survived by two daughters, Mrs. Ned (Nancy) Conradi and Mrs. Thomas (Joyce) Wente, both of New Bremen; seven grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; a brother, Warren, St. Henry; and three sisters, Mrs. Wilbert (Gladys) Gruebmeier, Helen Wissman and Mrs. Mack (Vernita) Wellman, all of New Bremen. He was preceded in death by a brother, Paul.

Mr. Brockman was a retired farmer, a member of the Auglaize County Farm Bureau and in past years raised and sold draft horses. He was a member of the Home Benefit Association. He was a member of St. Paul United Church of Christ.

Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at Gilberg Funeral Home with the Rev. Jeffrey R. Gerber officiating. Burial will be in [German Protestant Cemetery](#).

Friends may call from 2 to 4 and 6 to 8 p.m. Friday at the funeral home.
