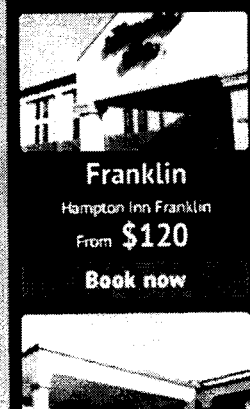

## Frank H. Buschman

In the death of Mr. Frank H. Buschman there passed from off the stage of community action a man who spent his entire life among the people who have employed their trust and hard labor of the task of developing this locality to a state of high excellency. It is a noteworthy fact that the last 30 years of his life were lived within the confines of this immediate territory and that what he done with his hands and placed with his brain was attributed primarily by a purpose to give advice to those who lived round and about him.

The death of Mr. Buschman occurred on Tuesday, February 20, 1923, and it followed an illness of perhaps five weeks. He became a gripper patient at the time when this disease began to trouble his people, but did not show symptoms that were alarming until about one week prior to his passing away. Like all people who have attained to such an advanced age he was no longer fortified with a robust constitution and was rather anxious for the reality. He showed the signs with striking courage until about the close of February. It was he retired to a sick room chamber, from which he never emerged alive.

Mr. Buschman was a familiar character among the people of this locality from greater length of existence to the history of the average man. He was born in Shelby county, Ohio, of farmer parents and he grew to maturity. As to his life's work there are no particularly

particulars of the manner and character of the most best natured by noting that he took that place in the world he thought he was best qualified to fill and believed along duty, having not the least concern about the opinion of the world as to whether he was doing anything more or less than the proper by his side.

He was married during the month of May, 1868, to Miss Mary Hayden and there are eight living children from the union. Four sons, Joseph, Henry, and Fred, and one daughter, William. Minster, Ohio daughter, Rose and Gertrude. He was the father of the late, Elizabeth Stueve at Minster and Mary Stueve at Osgood. There are also two grandchildren and twelve great grandchildren. Grandchildren, Rosamond, Howard and Charles, daughter, Lucille, Mary, and others.

Following the line of a farmer Mr. Buschman met with a somewhat portion of success and at the time of his death was the owner of a considerable tract of land in a corner south of Minster. It was in this place where he lived a great portion of his life and his country was never far from him.

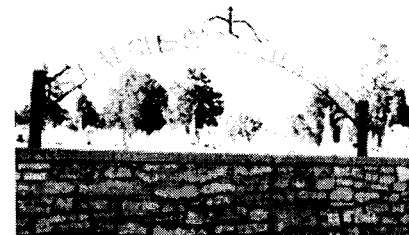

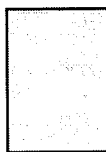
