Rev. J. C. Meichert paster of St. Paul church, officiated Tuesday after-noon at the funeral service conducted for John Herman Henry Blase, 89, whose death at 7:00 o'clock Saturday morning followed an extended illness with heart disease. The services were held from the late residence, west of New Bremen. Burial took place in the German Protestant cemetery.

Mr. Blase was a lifelong resident of this community and one of its best known farmers. He was forn October 2, 1864, and reached the age of 69 years, 8 months, and 14 days.

Mr. Blase was married twice, his

first wife having been Miss Mary

Brueggeman.

Surviving members of the imme-diate family are the widow, Mrs. Emma Uetrecht Blase; a son, Harry Blase, New Bremen; two daughters, Mrs. Arnold Luebkeman, New Bre-men, Mrs. Esther Shrader, Dayton; and a stepson, Wm. Uetrecht, Kettlersville. Assister, Mrs. Anna Hespe, Sidney, also survives him.


