Illness Claims Carl Brandewie

Carl H. Brandewie, age 65, 142 East 8th St., Minster, died suddenly at 3:15 p.m. Saturday at Joint Township Memorial Hospital where he was under treatment 12 days for a heart ailment. He was a retired farmer of the Egypt area.

Mr. Brandewie was vice president of the Osgood State Bank. He had served for 20 years as a member of the former Jackson Township No. 2 school board. He was a member of St. Augustine Catholic Church, Minster, the Holy Name Society, the Knights of Columbus in Minster, the Knights of St. John in Maria Stein and the Egypt Community Club.
