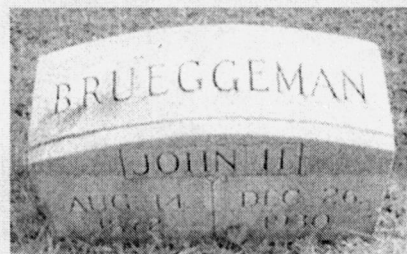
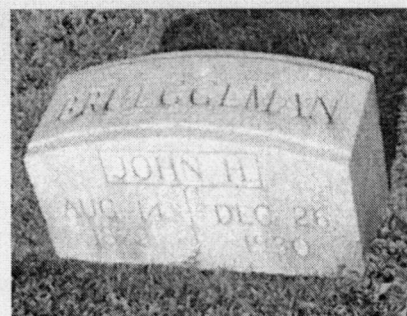
Pneumonia Causes Death Of Former
New Bremen Resident At Cleveland
[N.B. Sun - 12/31/1930]

Private funeral services for John Brueggeman, 58, former resident of New Bremen, who died Friday at Cleveland, were conducted yesterday afternoon from the home of a sister, Mrs. Fred Hegemier, South Walnut street, with Rev. J. C. Melchert officiating. Burial was had in the German Protestant cemetery.

A son of the late Mr. and Mrs. William Brueggeman, Mr. Brueggeman was born August 14, 1872, on a farm northwest of New Bremen. In 1895 he was united in marriage with Miss Caroline Zwez. Mrs. Brueggeman died in the following year and four years later Mr. Brueggeman married Miss Maude Montgomery of Cleveland. He had been a resident of that city for more than 25 years.

Mr. Brueggeman's death followed a brief illness with pneumonia. The body arrived here Sunday evening and was taken immediately to the Hegemier home.

Surviving members of the immediate family are the widow, Mrs. Maude Brueggeman; and two sons, Frederick and Adrian Brueggeman.
