Deceased was born in German township Oct. 4, 1869, as the daughter of P. William Brueggeman and wife nee Neuman now Mrs. Fred Tellman. She was united in marriage Dec. 3, 1891, to Mr. John Blase. One son and 2 daughters were born to the union. The deceased took sick about 3 years ago, and despite the best of medical at-tendance and nursing, life ebbed away gradually.

The immediate relations are the husband, 1 son, 2 daughters, parents, mother-in-law, 1 brother, 1 sister, 3 hrothers-in-law. 5 sisters. in-law.
