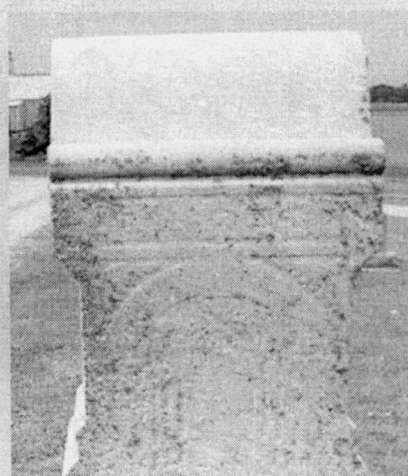

Mrs. Maria Sophia Blase, nee Brueggeman, died at her home about 5 miles north-west of here, at nine o'clock, a. m., on Friday Sept. 28, at the age of 30 years, 11 months and 24 days.

Deceased was born in German township Oct. 4, 1869, as the daughter of P. William Brueggeman and wife nee Neuman now Mrs. Fred Tellman. She was united in marriage Dec. 3, 1891, to Mr. John Blase. One son and 2 daughters were born to the union. The deceased took sick about 3 years ago, and despite the best of medical attendance and nursing, life ebbed away gradually.

The immediate relations are the husband, 1 son, 2 daughters, parents, mother-in-law, 1 brother, 1 sister, 3 brothers-in-law, 5 sisters-in-law.

Funeral took place Monday afternoon. Interment at the Protestant cemetery. Rev. Bertram conducted the services. [NB Sun-10/5/1900]
