MAN WHO DIED AFTER ACCIDENT AT DAYTON

The body of August T. Fischer was brought to Minster from Dayton and it will be interred on Saturday morning in the St. Augustine cemetery. The man died on Wednesday morning of this week from injuries received in an accident and arrangements were made for the funeral and burial took place in this city because he was a native of this community. His father was the late John Fischer and his mother was Jane Schemmel Fischer, who survives.

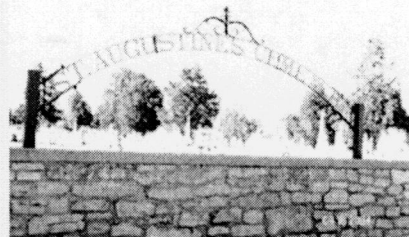
The man served for a period of ten years as the foreman at the Spitzler tobacco ware house at Dayton and it was while he was performing his duties there that the fatal accident took place. At about ten o'clock on Wednesday morning he fell backwards while in the act of loading a box of tobacco into a freight car. The box was being skidded over an iron runway and when the track gave way the men fell backwards to strike a solid concrete platform that was used for loading purposes.

He was put into an ambulance at once and was hastened to the St. Elizabeth hospital, but he was dead when the institution was reached. He sustained a broken neck in the fall and passed away very soon after he was put in the invalid car.

He was born on a farm east of Minster on Aug 24, 1888, and was consequently aged 47 years, 11 months and 25 days at the time of his death. Besides his mother, he is survived by one sister and one brother, who are Mrs. John L. Lyons of Cincinnati, and Ben Fischer, Jr., who resides in Minster. His father died about five years ago.

The deceased was reared in this community and he learned the moulder's trade at one of the institutions in Minster. As a workman in that line he was employed during one period in Piqua and at another time in New York. Although absent from his native locality for many years, he is still vividly remembered by many local people.

On Saturday morning at 9 o'clock, the funeral will be held at the St. Augustine church and

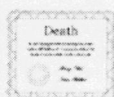
