

JOHN FISCHER DEAD AT HOME AFTER YEAR'S ILLNESS; WAS PIONEER OF THIS LOCALITY

John Fischer, 76, pioneer resident of Minster, died at 9 p.m. Tuesday at his farm home three miles southeast of town, concluding an illness of nearly a year. Death was attributed to complications.

Following a major operation underwent at St. Rita's hospital at Lima slightly less than a year ago, his health failed steadily until, several months ago, his condition was regarded as grave. He lost his eyesight almost immediately after returning from the hospital, and for the last four months was bedfast.

Mr. Fischer was a lifelong resident of this locality. He was born on a farm one and one half miles east of Minster on April 12, 1855, and died on the family homestead, where he had lived since his marriage in 1884. He was widely known in three parts of Auglaize and Shelby counties.

His parents, Bernard and Elizabeth Fischer, both immigrated to this country from Germany. They met in Minster and were married here. Both have been dead for many years.

In 1884, Mr. Fischer was married to Jane Schemmel, in St. Augustine church here. Rev. Fr. Anthony Kunkler read the ceremony. Since that time they lived together on the home farm near Lake Loramie, which Mrs. Fischer now occupies alone.

Six children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Fischer, two of whom died in infancy. Two sons and two daughters are living. They are Mrs. Millie Horman and Mrs. Clara Lyons of Cincinnati; August of Dayton; and Ben of Minster. Two sons, Peter and Joseph, are dead.

Mr. Fischer was a member of the St. Augustine church congregation here, and up to the time of his illness was an active member of the St. Boniface Benevolent society. He died fortified with the last sacraments of the Catholic church.

Funeral services were set for Friday at 9 a.m. at St. Augustine church with interment in the church cemetery.
