LOUIS G. FISCHER DIES AT 87; RITES THURSDAY

Louis G. Fischer, aged 87, a business leader in Minster 40 years prior to his retirement in 1941, died at 2:40 p.m. Sunday at Joint Township Memorial Hospital in St. Marys. He had been in failing health a year and seriously ill four days. He was admitted to the hospital on Saturday.

Mr. Fischer operated a food store here from 1901 until 1934 when his sons took over the business now operated by them as Fischer's Supermarket. For a number of years and until 1941, he owned and operated the Minster Canning company.

He served many years on the boards of directors of the Industrial Equipment Company and the Minster State Bank, and retired from both directorships five years ago. He was vice president of the bank board at his retirement.

Mr. Fischer was a member of the St. Augustine's church and the Holy Name Society of the church, and a charter member of the Minster Eagles Lodge, and held membership in the St. Augustine Orphan Society and was a charter member of the Cataract Fire company.

A native of St. Louis, Mo., he was the son of Bernard and Elizabeth (Bockrath) Fischer. He married Alma Roettger here Oct 18, 1910. She survives as do two daughters, Mrs. Henry (Delores) Krampe of Flint, Mich., and Mrs. Herbert (Irene) Hegemann of Minster; two sons, Ralph and Albert J., both of Minster; 10 grandchildren and 22 great-grandchildren.

There are three sisters, Mrs. Anna Schmitmeyer of Sidney; Mrs. Frances Bustetter of Wapakoneta; and, Mrs. Rose Russell of Flint, Mich.; and two brothers, John of Minster; and George of Flint, Mich. Three brothers are dead.

Solemn Requiem High Mass will be celebrated in St. Augustine's Church a 9 a.m. Thursday by the pastor, the Rev. William Meyer. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.


