Roger W. Frericks, age 33, of 196 N. Frankfort st., Minster, died of a heart attack at Joint Township Memorial hospital, St. Marys, at 1:15 a.m. Monday. He had suffered the attack late Sunday afternoon and was taken to the hospital at that time. Mr. Frericks was ailing with a blood disease for the last six weeks.

A native of Minster, he was born Oct. 27, 1923, the son of John and Matilda Rees Frericks. He had never married.

Surviving are five sisters, Miss Hilda and Miss Rose Frericks, both of Minster; Mrs. Mary Kirsh, Troy; Mrs. Richard (Leta) Gauvey, West Palm Beach, Florida and Miss Cornelia Frericks, Dayton, and five brothers, Leo, Frank, Clifford and Robert Frericks, all of Minster and John Frericks, Elphos.
