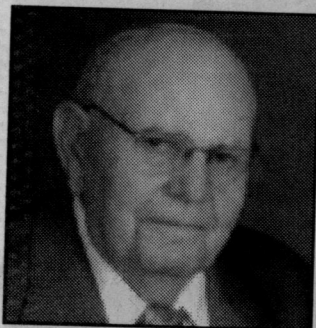


Paul E. Freytag
