Heart Attack Claims Charles Knob

Charles W. Knob, age 75, of R. R. 2, Anna, died sometime Thursday of an apparent heart attack according to Dr. John Marsh, Shelby County coroner. He was found at his farm residence two miles southwest of Anna on the Miranda Road at 9:00 Friday morning by a neigh-

bor, Orville Winner.

A native of McCartyville, he was born June 11, 1894, to Bernard and Elizabeth Schaaf Knob.

On October 17, 1915, he married Amelia Deiters who died August 25, 1958. Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Jack (Irene) Williams of Dayton and Mrs.

William (Evelyn) DeShurko, Dayton; four grandchildren and two brothers, Bernard, of Sidney Lawrence of Santa Cruz, California. One sister is deceased.

Mr. Knob was a retired farmer. He was a member of the Sacred Heart Catholic Church, McCartyville and the St. Joseph's Men's Society. Rev. Fr. Clarence Diegelman offered a funeral mass at 10:30 a.m. Monday in the church. Burial was in the church cemetery.
