James H. Larger, 52, 9054 State Route 66, vice president of Frantz Brothers Inc., Sidney, died Sunday at 11 a.m. at Piqua Memorial Hospital where he was taken after suffering an apparent heart attack at this home.

He was born Aug. 7, 1928, in Fort Loramie, son of Henry and Amelia (Broering) Larger.

On January 5, 1956, he and the former Shirley A. Hein were married in Coldwater.

She survives with eight children, Lee and Jean, both of Dayton; Jane, Mark, Steve, Karen, Mary and Jeff, all at home; a grandchild, two sisters, Georgian Hoving of St. Patrick, and Mrs. Thomas (Norma) Tompkins of Minster; and a brother Richard of Minster.
