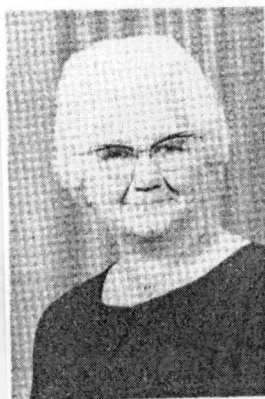


Mrs. Middendorf Succumbs To Illness

Mrs. Agnes Sophia Middendorf, age 61, of 69 South Main, Ft. Laramie, died at 3:35 a.m. Friday at Wilson Memorial Hospital, Sidney, of a heart condition. She had been ill two years.

A native of R. R. 1, Minster she was born June 28, 1908, the daughter of the late William and Caroline Strukamp Meyer. She had lived in Shelby County all her life.

On October 5, 1926, she was married to Charles T. Middendorf. He survives with three children, Richard Middendorf and Max Middendorf, both of Ft. Laramie, and Carl Middendorf of R. R. 1, Houston. One son, Arthur, died in December, 1936.

Also surviving are 13 grandchildren, a sister, Mrs. Leonard (Mary) Liesner, New Bremen, and four brothers, Julius Meyer, R. R. 1, Houston; Lawrence Meyer, Piqua; Aloysius Meyer, Sidney, and Urban Meyer, Van Wert.

Mrs. Middendorf was a past president of the Catholic Ladies of Columbia, a member of the St. Michael Church, Ft. Laramie and the Apostleship of Prayer and the St. Ann Altar Rosary Sodality of the church.

Funeral rites took place Monday at 11 a.m. in the St. Michael Church, Ft. Laramie, with the Rev. John Brueker officiating. Burial followed in St. Michael Cemetery.
