Irwin J. Morsey



Irwin J. Morsey, 65, 162 S. Hanover St., died Thursday at 10:55 p.m. at St. Marys Joint Township Dist. Memorial Hospital. He had been ill five years.

He was born April 4, 1917, in Minster, son of Anton J. and Anna (Helmsing) Morsey.

On Oct. 22, 1938, he and the former Hilda Heintz were married. She survives with two daughters, Mrs. Rick (Mary) Kinsella of Lima, and Mrs. Wayne (Annette) Meyer, R.R. 2, Minster, four

grandchildren; and a brother, Royal of Muncie, Ind.

Mr. Morsey retired from the Minster Machine Tool Co. where he had worked 25 years. He was also a former funeral director and embalmer for the former Heintz Funeral Home in Minster and a former barber. He was a World War II veteran of the U.S. Army-Air Corps, and a member of St. Augustine Catholic Church; the St. Augustine Men's Choir for 25 years; and the Holy Name Society of the church; the American Legion; the Eagles Lodge; the Veterans of Foreign Wars of which he was past commander; all of Minster. He had also been a deputy registrar for several years.

Services were held Monday at 11 a.m. at the church with the Rev. David Heintz and the Rev. Ferd LaManna officiating. Burial followed in the church cemetery.
