

Wm. Nedderman Rites Held Tues.

William Nedderman, 87, retired farmer, died at 5:05 p.m. Saturday in the Valley Nursing Home, St. Marys, where he had been a patient for the past six months.

He was born on March 2, 1879, in Auglaize County, a son of the late William and Wilhelmina Niemeyer Nedderman. He moved to New Bremen in 1947 from a farm northwest of there.

He was twice married, first to Mrs. Florantina Witte on May 14, 1904. She died in 1919. On July 2, 1930, he married Elizabeth Miller, who preceded him in death in 1959.

He is survived by four sons, Alfred of R. R. 1, St. Marys, Forrest of Findlay, Marvin of New Bremen and Robert Nedderman of R. R. 1, New Bremen; 10 grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; and three brothers, Leo of R. R. 1, New Knoxville, Ed of St. Marys and Lafe Nedderman of Houston, Texas.

Two sisters, Elizabeth Doenges and Sophia Bertke, and a brother, Fred, are deceased.

He was a member of the St. Paul's United Church of Christ.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Vornholt Funeral Home with Rev. James Egbert officiating. Burial was made in the German Protestant Cemetery.
