

MRS. FRED TELLMAN

[N.B. Sun - 11/24/1922]

Mrs. Wilhelmine Tellman, widow of the late Fred Tellman, died at the home of her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Fred Hegemeier, east of town, Sunday afternoon at 1:15 o'clock. Her death occurred after an illness of only several days, although she had been suffering a general break-down for the past year and which was probably caused by the infirmities of old age, as she had attained the age of 75 years. 5 months and 5 days at the time of her demise.

Mrs. Tellman, nee Withelmine Neuman, was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Bernhard Neuman and was born on the parental farm close Search now

to New Bremen on June 14, 1847. On August 12, 1868, she was united in marriage with John Brueggeman. Three children were born of this union, including Mrs. John Blase, who died during the year 1900; Mrs. Fred Hegemeier, residing on a farm several miles east of New Bremen; and John Brueggeman of Cieveland. The husband died on Aug. 17, 1883, and six years later, Nov. 8, 1889, the widow entered into a second marriage with Fred Teilman. On April 15, 1915, Mr. Tellman died and Mrs. Tellman then sold her property on North Herman street and spent the remaining years of her life with her daughter.

She is survived by two children, John Brueggeman of Cleveland, and Mrs. Fred Hegemeier; four stepchildren, John Tellman and August Tellman of Ft. Wayne, Ind.; Mrs. Henry Fark of Crosby, Minn; and Mrs. H. A: Schrage; nine grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Her passing away is also mourned by three sisters, Mrs. Herman Bruns and Mrs. John Oswald of Fort Wayne; and Mrs. Wm. Bolander of Piqua; four brothers, August Neuman of Troy; Wm. Neuman of Lima; Louis Neuman of Birmingham, Ala.; and George Neuman of l'exas.

Funeral services were conducted at the Hegemeier home. Wednesday afternoon at 1 o'clock, followed by a short-service in St. Peters church at 1:30. Interment occurred on the German Protestant cemetery.


