Death Occurs For Josephine Riethman, 78

Services To Be Friday For
Longtime Minster
Resident

Funeral services will be conducted in St. Augustine's church at 9 a. m. Friday for Mrs. Josephine Riethman, aged 78 years and eight months, a resident of Minster many years, whose death occurred in her residence, 121 South Hanover street, at 10:30 a. m. Monday.

Rev. Fr. Otto Mueller will offer requiem high mass for the aged woman, who had been ill for a year with complications and bedfast the last three weeks preceding her death. Burial will be in the church cemetery.

A native of Maria Stein, Mrs. Riethman was born Oct. 4, 1867, a daughter of Henry and Elisabeth Piening Plageman. She married Joseph Riethman Sept. 25, 1889 and he died March 2, 1940. They celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in 1939.

Surviving are four children, Miss Emma Riethman, Lima, and Miss Clara, Minster; Louis Riethman, Lima, and Albert, Urbana; two grandchildren, Mrs. F. P. Frye, Crestline, and Margaret Ann Riethman, Lima.

Mrs. Elizabeth Wagner, Lima, and Mrs. Agatha Riethman, Minster, are sisters.

Mrs. Riethman was a charter member of the auxiliary of the American Legion and a member of the Knights of St. John auxiliary. She received the last sacrament of the Catholic church of which she was a lifelong member. She was enrolled in the St. Monica society of the church here.
