Rites Held For Ralph H. Pleiman, Father Of Four

Ralph H. Pleiman, 34-year-old dairy farmer of R. R. 1, Yorkshire, died at 2:00 p.m. Saturday in Wilson Memorial Hospital, Sidney, where he had been admitted early Saturday morning. He was a rheumatic heart victim and had been suffering with an attack of asthma for the past ten days.

He was born on May 13, 1931, on a farm four miles west of Fort Loramie on the Dark-Shelby county line road where he resided all his life.

On August 8, 1959, he married Margaret Wap-pelhorst who survives with his parents, Albert and Eleanor Fischer Pleiman, Fort Loramie, four children, Rebecca, age 5, Anita, age 3, Robert, age 2, and Randy Pleiman, age six months.

Also surviving are five sisters, Mrs. Linus (Virginia) Pohl of Coldwater, Mrs. Clifford (Charlene) Meyer and Mrs. Marion (Angela) Philpot of Russia, Mrs. Dean (Mary Jane) Steink of Botkins and Mrs. Joseph (Norma Jean) Toller of Fort Loramie; and one brother, Lester Pleiman of Osgood.

Two sisters are deceased.

He was a member of the St. Michael Catholic Church, Fort Loramie, the St. Joseph's Men's Society and the Apostleship of Prayer.

Funeral services were held in the church at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday with Rev. John Brucker as celebrant of the mass. Burial followed in the church cemetery.
