

Anna Egbert Dies Following Illness

Mrs. Anna Marie Egbert, 76, wife of Edward Egbert, of R. R. I, Minster, died at 4 a.m. Monday at her home after an extended illness. She had been ill since suffering a cerebral hemorrhage 17 months ago.

Born Dec. 30, 1889 in Auglatze County, she was a daughter of Henry and Rosina Wessling Rempe.
