

Albert Rulmann Dies In Flint; Rites Here

Funeral services were conducted in St. Augustine's church Wednesday morning for Albert (Bert) Rulmann, aged 68 years and nine months, who died at 10 p. m. Saturday in St. Joseph hospital in Flint, Mich. Rev. Otto Mueller officiated. Burial was made in the church cemetery.

Mr. Rulmann, a native of Minster, who operated a drug store here prior to going to Michigan about 1910, was ill for nine months and bedfast eight weeks.

He was born Aug. 15, 1881, the son of R. A. and Isabella Schmieder Rulmann. Survivors are his wife, the former Nora Goetze, and a son, LeRoy, in Flint, and two half-brothers, Herbert and Oscar Rulmann of here. The late Dr. Clarence and Roy Rulmann also were half-brothers.

Mr. Rulmann, who was an employe of the Buick division of GMC at Flint many years, was a member of St. Mathew's church in that city.
