Former Ft. Loramie Resident Is Claimed

Henry J. Sturwold, 82, Who Left Here Five Years Ago, Dies At Dayton

Henry J. Sturwold, aged 82, a native of Germany and for many years a resident of near Ft. Loramie, died at 8:30 p. m. last Saturday in the home of a daughter, Mrs. Urban Gudorf, at Dayton, after an illness of one year from old age complications.

Mr. Sturwold came to this country with his parents when a young man, and the family settled in the Ft. Loramie community. He spent the remainder of his life as a farmer there until five years ago, when, after the death of his wife, he went to Dayton to make his home with his son-in-law and daughter. He had lived on a farm west of Ft. Loramie.

Born in Oldenburg, Germany, on July 21, 1857 he came to the Ft. Loramie community in 1881 and married Mary Buessing on April 28, 1885. She died Sept. 4, 1894. On May 20, 1896 he married Bernardine Reiesing. She preceded him in death also. Three children were born to the first union and two to the second.

Mr. Sturwold lived on a farm one and a half miles west of Ft. Loramie until June of 1926, when he established his residence


