Former Ft. Loramie Resident Is Claimed

Henry J. Sturwold, 82, Who Left Here Five Years Ago, Dies At Dayton

ad Henry J. Sturwold, aged 82, a native of Germany and for many years a resident of near Ft. Loramic, died at 8:30 p. m. last Saturday in the home of a daughter, Mrs. Urban Gudorf, Oct. Dayton after a liberton of the same at Dayton, after an illness of one year from old age complications.

Mr. Sturwold came to this country with his parents when a young man, and the family settled in the Ft. Loramic community. He spent the remainder of his life as a farmer there until five years ago, when, after the death of his wife, he went to Dayton to make his home with his son-in-law and daughter. He had lived on a farm west of Ft Loramie.

Born in Oldenburg, Germany, on July 21, 1857 he came to the nd Ft. Loramic community in 1881 nd and married Mary Buessing on in-April 28, 1885. She died Sept. ck. 4, 1894. On May 20, 1896 he m- married Bernadine Reiering. She er, preceded him in death also. Three children were born to the ed first union and two to the second.

Mr. Sturwold lived on a farm ing one and a half miles west of Ft. Ing Loramic until June of 1926, when he established his residence Borel
