

**Rites Held For  
Katherine  
Kemper, Age 95**

Mrs. Katherine Kemper, 95, of R. R. 1, Minster, died at 3:45 p.m. last week Thursday at her residence on the Minster-Fort Recovery road two miles west of Minster. She had been active up until nine weeks ago when she suffered a fractured hip. Complications set in, causing her death.

She was born on September 24, 1870, in Maria Stein, a daughter of the late Joseph and Elizabeth Whorman Thobe. On June 11, 1890, she married Anton Kemper who preceded her in death on June 18, 1945.

There are seven surviving children: Mrs. Edward (Bernadine) Jacobs, Mrs. Harry (Anna) Schwieterman, Mrs. Urban (Alvina) Heitkamp and Louis Kemper, all of Minster, Mrs. Hugo (Loretta) Schwieterman of Dayton, Joseph Kemper of Maria Stein and William Kemper, with whom she resided.
