

**Mrs. Joe Thieman
Rites Held Wed.**

Mrs. Amelia Thieman, age 83, of R. R. 1, Minster, residing one and one-half miles northwest of Minster on state route 119, died Sunday at 10:30 a.m. at Joint Township Memorial hospital, St. Marys. She had been a patient there for eleven days and had been in failing health for five years.
