

Orchard Lake Mayor Dave Boerger is a Fort Loramie native

Fort Loramie native is now mayor of small Michigan city

The recently-elected mayor of Orchard Lake, Michigan is Ft. Loramie native, Dave Boerger.

The lakefront residential community, located about 35 miles northwest of Detroit, has a population of 2,200.

Boerger has served on the City's Planning Commission and City Council before becoming mayor earlier this year. In addition, he was assistant to the president at Kettering University, in Flint, Michigan since 2000, after retiring as a vice president with Ford Motor Company, where he served for 27 years.

Boerger is a 1966 graduate of Ft. Loramie High School, attended General Motors Institute where he received an engineering degree and then obtained an MBA from the University of Michigan.

He is married to the former Debby Francis of Russia, and they have one grown son, Reggie, who lives and works in Holly, Michigan. Boerger is a member of several civic, public and non-profit boards and organizations, plus also is an executive consultant performing due diligence for private equity firms involved in margers and acquisitions.
