

business which is now the trucking firm known as J. B. Ahrns and Sons.

For many years Mr. Ahrns operated his business with teams, earrying out contracts which he held for transportation of freight to and from the Nickel Plate railfead and Western Ohio railway agencies here. In later years he purchased motor trucks. It was in 1934 that his sons were taken into partnership with him. Surviving in addition to his widow are five sons and two daughters, namely Bernard of Deerwood, Mich.; William, Deshler, O.; Charles, Louis and Richard Ahrns and Mrs. Ellen Koester, West Alexandria, O. William was at his father's bedside at the time of his passing. Four children, Henry, August, Clemens and Carolina, are dead.

A sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Harting, resides at Cleveland and a John B. Ahrns, aged 75, widely-known resident of Minster and a business man here for more than a half-century, died Wednesday at 9 p. m. in the Findts Convalescent Home at Maumee, where he had been a patient nearly two years.

Death concluded an illness of more than three years from hardening of the arteries. A paralytic stroke suffered a week before hastened the end. Mr. Altrns' condition was described as critical from that time until he passed peacetully us he slout. Born in Ft. Loramie on Aug. 4, 1863 he was a son of the late Henry and Carolina (Zinmerman) Ahrns, pioneers of that place. He attended schools of Ft. Loramie and spent his boyhood there. He came to Minster at the age of 21.

On Jan. 28, 1835 he was married to Anna Klein of Minster in St. Augustine's church bere. Wr. and Mrs. Ahrns enjoyed the musual privilege of celebrating their golden wedding anniversary in 1935 at their home here. Upon coming to Minster Mr. Ahrns opened a cafe and cigar store on West Fourth street, in the building now occupied by the billiard room of the Rulmann Recreation. Later he moved the business into a building which he receted on South Frankfort street immediately south of the Laufersweiler building off West Fourth street. Forty-four years ago he established the draying [Minster Post - 9/30/1938]
