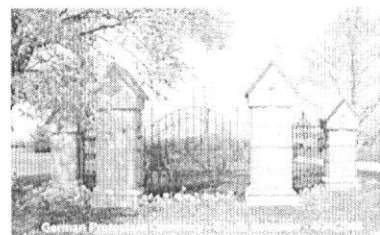

RICHARD S. BERGMAN, 89, of 04657 Lock Two Rd., New Bremen, OH., died on Wednesday, February 23, 2011 at 5:58 P.M. in the Emergency Room of Joint Twp. Dist. Mem. Hospital, St. Marys, OH. He was born on April 10, 1921 near Maria Stein, OH, the son of Lawrence and Frances (Bruns) Bergman. On October 3, 1953 he married Ivalou Greve who survives near New Bremen. Also surviving are his children; Diane (Ron) Moeller of Peninsula, OH., Rebecca (Rolf) Wielick of Seattle, WA., Lisa (Bob) Moeller of New Bremen, Dan Bergman of New Bremen and Greg (Karen) Bergman of Bowling Green, OH.; his grandchildren: Elizabeth, Erin and Emelie Moeller, Lia and Lindsey Wielick and Benjamin and Brooke Bergman. 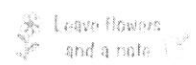
