Thursday Rites For Norman H. Berning

A solemn requiem high mass was intoned at 9 a.m. Thursday with Rev. John Spatt officiating for Norman H. Berning, 52, of R. 1, Minster. Mr. Berning died at 6:45 p.m. Saturday in Joint Township Memorial hospital, St. Marys, where he had been a patient for three days. A complicated heart condition caused his death. He had been ill for several years.

Born August 24, 1912 in Minster, he was a son of the late Bernard and Josephine Heckman Berning. He was engaged in farming most of his life at his home on State Route 119 about three miles east of Minster. He never married.

Mr. Berning is survived by four sisters, Mrs. Walter (Clara) Bensman, Mrs. Matt (Henrietta) Schenkel, Mrs. Clem (Marie) Feldman and Mrs. Edwin (Alvera) Baumer, and a brother, Edwin, all of Minster. He was preceded in death by one brother, William.

He was a member of the St. Augustine Catholic church and the Cataract Fire Co.

The Hogenkamp Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements.
