# Bernard Boecker

Death struck unexpectedly in the home of one of Minstor's oldest families last Sunday afternoon and claimed one of the oldest residents of the community when Bernard Boccker succumb-

ed to a sudden heart attack.

Mr. Boecker, whose health for one of his advanced age had in recent years been considered unusually good, was stricken in his home at 148 North Main street and died within 15 minutes. He was in his 92nd year.

Funeral services were conducted in St. Augustine's church Thursday morning, the Rev. Theodore Koenn offering the requiem high mass at 9 a. m. Interment followed in the church cemetery.

Born in Minster April 12, 1852-Mr. Boecker was a son of the late Henry and Chara Ruhe Boecker, natives of Germany. He grow to manhood in this community and was married in 1880 to Miss Elizabeth Ripploh who died ton years later. In 1897 he was married to Miss Katherine Ruemping, who also preceded him in death, in 1940.

Surviving are three children, Mrs. Alvina Liets of St. Marys, and Andrew W. and Henry B. Boscker of here. There are six grandchildren and two great grandchildren. Mrs. Clara Heckman of Minster is a sister. Two sisters and a brother are dead.

Mr. Boocker followed the trade of earpenter in Minster and the surrounding community for many years up to about ten years ago, when he retired. He was a lifelong Catholle, and received the last sacrament of the church. He was a member of the St. Angustine society of the parish here.
