Funeral services were held in St. Augustine's church Tues-day morning for Mrs. Elizabeth Mary Stueve, aged 77 years and nine months, who died shortly before II a. m. Saturday in the family residence, 103 South Cleveland street, after an extended illness

Interment was made in the church burial ground.


