W. C. Buschman
Accident Worked As Janitor
Of Minster Schools
For 30 Years

Funeral services were held in the St. Augustine church at 120 s. n. Wednesday for William C. Buschman, aged 61 years and five months, lifelong Minster community resident, who died in his home at 250 North Frankfort street at 5:50 p.m. last Saturday. Death was attributed to complications.

The passing of Mr. Buschman was sudden despite the fact that he had ailed for more than a year. He had been up and around his residence at noon Saturday. During his illness he had been a patient for a time at the Dayton Good Samaritan hospital, where he submitted to a major operation.

Prior to the time failing health forced his retirement from work more than a year ago, Mr. Buschman had established an enviable record for continuous service in one job. He served as janitor for the Minster schools for a period of 30 consecutive years. Prior to entering the employ of the school system he had followed the occupation of farming.

Members of the teaching staff and pupils of the schools gathered together in the high school building to honor Mr. Buschman, at the time he marked completion of his 25th year as a school employe. This was an emotion in his life that he held dear in his memory from that time until his death.

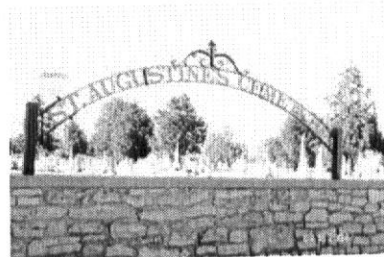
Born July 30, 1880, on the farm a short distance south of Minster which now is operated by his brother Henry, he was a son of the late Frank and Mary (Hoying) Buschman. His marriage to Miss Nora Kuhlman, who survives, was an event of Oct. 7, 1903, in the St. Augustine church here.

Included among survivors are six brothers and sisters, namely, Mrs. Elizabeth Stueve, Minster; Mrs. Mary Stueve, Osgood; Joseph, Henry and Miss Gertrude Buschman, residing on the home farm, and Fred Buschman, of Minster.

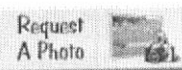
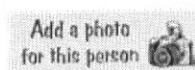

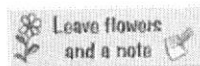
