

Decedent Worked As Janitor
Of Minster Schools

Of Minster School For 30 Years

Funeral services were held in the St. Augustine church at \$30 a. m. Wednesday for Wilfam C. Buschman, aged 61 gars and five months, lifelong Minster community resident, the died in his home at 256 North Frankfort street at 5:50 a.m. last Saturday. Death was attributed to complications.

Prior to the time failing health fixed his retirement from work more than a year ago, Mr. Buschman had established an envisible record for continuous service in one job. He served a janitor for the Minster schools for a period of 30 consecutive pars. Prior to entering the employ of the school system he had followed the occupation of farming.

Members of the teaching staff and pupils of the schools gathered together in the high school building to honor Mr. Buschman, at the time he marked completion of his 25th year as a school employee. This was an eccasion in his life that he held dear in his memory from that time until his death.

Born July 30, 1880, on the lam a short distance south of Minster which now is operated by his brother Henry, he was a san of the late Frank and Mary (Hoying) Buschman. His marnage to Miss Nora Kuhlman, who survives, was an event of Oct. 7, 1908, in the St. Augustiae church here.

Included among survivors are ix brothers and sisters, namely, Mrs. Elizabeth Stueve, Minster; Mrs. Mary Stueve, Osgood; Jesph, Henry and Miss Gertude Buschman, residing on the lame farm, and Fred Buschman, of Minster.

A lifelong and faithful member of the Catholic church, Mr. Buschman was a member of the St. Augustine, St. Boniface and Holy Name societies of the St. Augustine parish.

The funeral services Wednesday were in charge of the Rev. Theodore Koenn. Burial was made in the St. Augustine cemetery. [Minster Post - 1/9/1942]
