J. Henry Doenges was a native of St. Marys township, having been born on the parental farm, two and one half miles north, on the present Mrs. John Doenges farm. Having grown to manhood and learned the trade of farming, he purchased his own farm over tifty years ago, out in Mercer county, seven miles northwest, and marrying Miss Sophie Hoff the young couple took possession of the farm where they resided until the death of the husband, and gained distinction as successful farmers and excellent neighbors. Mr. Doenges was a diligent man, and personally supervised the management of his farm until a few, years ago when he delegated the job to his son-in-law, Cornelius Geib, and himself and wife decided to enjoy their closing days in case and comfort. A man of robust appearance and apparent great physical strength he was always looked at as a picture of health, and in fact for many years he continued in his ruggedness, until age and perhaps great physical trials through exposure and so on during the early years on the farm began to tell on him, and after taking to his bed a week before his death his strength waned and soon he was obliged to answer the summons from which there is no appeal. Funeral services were held this afternoon in St. Pauls church, Rev. Henninger officiating, and interment was had in the German-Protestant cemetery. He leaves the wife, 3 sons, Theo., Otto C. and Frank, and one daughter, Mrs. Cornelius Geib, besides several grand-children, one great-grandchild, 8 daughters-inlaw, one son-in-law, one brother Louis and numerous other relatives and friends. Last November Mr. and Mrs. Doenges had the pleasure of celebrating their Golden Wedding, mention of which was made in these columns at the time.


