MINSTER, Jan. 24 — Funeral services will be held in St. Augustine Catholic church here Monday at 9 a. m. for John G. Dues, 51, president and general manager of the Dues Machine Co., here and president of the Minster board of Education for 11 years, who died in Piqua Memorial hospital after a three-year illness from a heart ailment. He was bedfast three weeks and a hospital patient one week. Rev. Theodore Koenn will have charge of the services, with interment in the parish burial ground.

Dues, one of Minster's most widely-known residents, was born at Chickasaw on March 30, 1891. He married Katherine Brandewie on May 13, 1914. In 1919 he went to Georgia, operating a sawmill there three years, returning to Minster in 1922 to enter business with his father in the local factory, manufacturing corn huskers and shredders.

Surviving are his mother, his widow, and the following children: Mrs. Alvira Gudorf, and Georgina, Geneva, Lorena, Irvin and Paul Dues, all of Minster. Living brothers and sisters are Mrs. Bernadina Kuhn and Fred Dues, Minster, and Mrs. Mayme Friemering, Toledo. There are two grandchildren.

Dues was a member of St. Augustine society of the local Catholic church, and was a member of the Minster acerie of Eagles. He
