

## M. H. Falk, Sr.; Widely Known Lima Man, Dies



Max H. Falk, Sr., 89, of 123 W. Circular-st, retired pioneer Linus merchant, died at 230 p. m. Tuesday in St. Ritu's hospital. He had been in ill health about a year, but only seriously ill about a year, but only seriously ill about a week. Caming from Newport, Ky., at the age of 34 as manager of Edermon's Clothing Co., he served in that cupacity for several years, later becoming manager of The Alden-ee Mauseleum Co.

Falk was widely known in north-western Ohio musse and Cathelic lay and fraternal circles. He was a former member of the Linus Choral society and a director of St. John's church choir at the time of his death.

He seganized the St. John and St. Rose courts of the Cathelic Order of Foresters and was a district organizer for the order. He also was a member of the Linus lodge of Elks.
