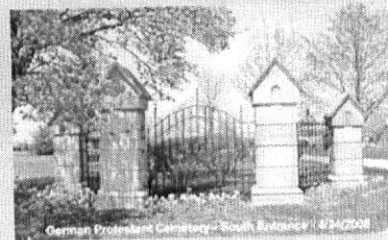

Henry Fark Died

[N.B. Sun - 1/23/1920]

Just before going to press this afternoon, the SUN was informed of the passing away of Henry Fark. Death occurred at the home of his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Huckeriede, northeast of town, with whom the deceased and his surviving wife had made their home since the middle of October. He had attained an age of 77 years. He was a life-long resident of New Bremen, a mason by trade. His passing away marks the close of an industrious life. He is survived by his wife, 9 sons, Ed Fark of Greensburg, Kan., Christ of Ellinwood, Kan., Henry of Crosby, Minn., Fred of Chicago, Wm. of St. Marys, Herman, George, Charles and Irvin Fark of here, also four daughters, Mrs. Fred Konen and Mrs. George Konen of Dayton, Mrs. Sylvan Greiner of Ft.
