

Funeral Rites For Mrs. Kaup at Burkettsville Well Known Resident Expires at Son's Home Last Night

Mrs. Gerhard Kaup, 73, of Burkettsville, died Wednesday night at 10 o'clock at the home of her son Anthony Kaup at Greenville. Death, due to heart trouble, followed a 10-day illness.

The deceased Elizabeth Fath Kaup was born in Des Moines, Iowa. March 17, 1866 and had reached the age of 78 years, 8 months and 12 days. She operated a store in Burkettsville for the past 13 years and was well known and respected in that vicinty.

The following children survie; Sister Albina of Cincinnati; Joe Kaup of Burkettsville; William Kaup of Versailles; John Kaup of Springfield and Anthony Kaup of Greenville.

Mrs. Kaup was a devout member of St. Bernard's Catholic Church at Burkettsville, and died well fortified with the last sacraments of her religion. She was also a member of the C.K. of A. and the Mother's Sodality.

Funeral services are arranged for Saturday morning at 8:30 o'clock at St. Bernard's Church at Burkettsville conducted by Reverend Fathers Rohling, Kramer and Kurll. Burial will be made in the church cemetery.

Death was attributed to a paralytic stroke which she had suffered ten days ago. The husband died in 1913.
