Henry A. Francis, 80, of Rt. 1, Houston, died Thursday at 11:35 a.m. in St. Elizabeth Medical Center, Dayton. He had been a patient there one week.

Born Feb. 27, 1891, he was the son of Louis F. and Adeline Reboulet Francis. He lived all his life in the Russia area. A retired farmer, he was a member of the Russia School Board several years and a charter member of the Russia Equity Grain Co.

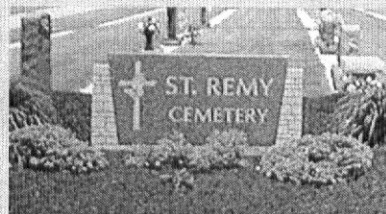
He was also a member of St. Remy Catholic Church, Russia, and Fraternal Order of Eagles, Minster.
