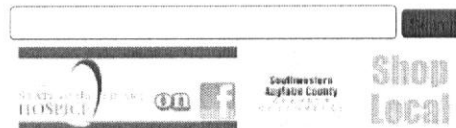
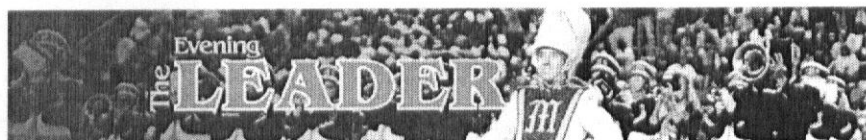

In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to Wilson Auxiliary or to Holy Angels Catholic Church. Envelopes will be available at the funeral home.

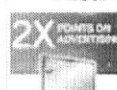
