DEATH OF ALFRED FRIEMERING

[N.B. Sun - 1/4/1940]

Mr. and Mrs. Al H. Friemering were called to Sidney, this morning, pursuant to a message announcing the sudden death of Mr. Friemering's brother, Alfred J. Friemering. At the time of going to press they had not returned home and details of the sudden passing could not be procured.

Mr. Friemering and his family for a number of years were residents of New Bremen and consequently are quite well known here wherefore the news of the sudden passing of Mr. Friemering has come as a real shock to their friends. He is survived by his wife, a sister, Mrs. Al H. Friemering, and by four children, the youngest one being about five weeks old. Since living in Sidney he was connected with the highway department.

A large group of local relatives and friends of the late Alfred Friemering, who died suddenly a week ago at Sidney, were in Minster, to attend the funeral services.
