## Fred Friemering

Frederick Friemering, aged 80 years, a native of Minster and a lifelong resident of this community, died at 3 p. m. Wednesday in the Piqua Memorial hospital, from complications arising from the effects of a fractured hip incurred in a fall eight weeks ago.

Mr. Friemering was enroute to church and fell on an icy pavement. He was taken to the hospital and the injured member was placed in a cast, and several days later he was brought to his home on South Cleveland street. He failed to recover from the injury. Ten days before his death he returned to the hospital.

Born in Minster on March 12, 1860, he was a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Friemering. On Nov. 26, 1916 he was married to Clara Mittler in St. Augustine's church. A farmer all his life until he was 50 years old, he retired in 1910 and moved into Minster, from the farm southwest of town on which Ben Bruns now resides.

He leaves his widow and three brothers, Bernard and Henry Friemering of Minster, and Joseph of Botkins. The following stepchildren are living: Joseph and Ben Bruns of near Osgood; John Bruns, Coldwater; Mrs. Mary Vanderhorst, Celina; Mrs. Josephine Lanfersieck and Mrs. Margaret Warner, New Bremen; Mrs. Henrietta Huelsman, Minster; and Leander Athmer, place of residence unknown.

Mr. Friemering was a member of the Catholic church, and was enrolled in the St. Augustine society of the local parish.

A requiem funeral high mass will be read in St. Augustine's church at 9 a. m. Monday. The pastor, Rev. Theodore Koenn, will officiate. Burial will be made in the St. Augustine cemetery.

The pallbearers will be Clarence Busse, Charles Berning, William Olding, Henry Wildenhans, Clifford Quellhorst and Henry Schwenzer.
