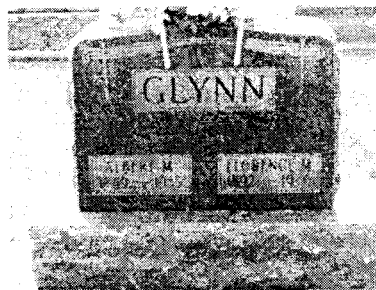

 We miss you most who loved you best.

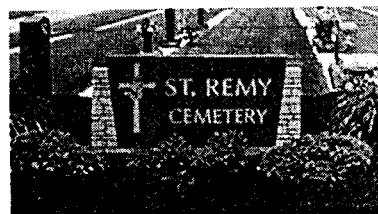
"Eternal rest grant to him, O Lord,
