## Paul D. Headapohl, 90

Paul D. Headapohl, 90, of 109 S. Front St., New Bremen, died at 5:30 p.m. on Friday, December 21, 2001 at Joint Township District Memorial Hospital in St. Marys.

He was born on July 30, 1911 in Wapakoneta to Daniel and Leona (Laut) Headapohl. On May 18, 1937, he married Viola Hirschfeld who survives in New Bremen.

He is survived by a daughter, Diane (Robert) Paul of New Bremen, and three grandchildren, Jeff (Renee) Paul, Kelli (David) Mueher and Greg Paul.

He is also survived by a sister, Esther Dicke of New Bremen.

Mr. Headapohl was a member of the St. Paul United Church of Christ in New Bremen and had taught Sunday School for over 30 years. He had held various offices of the church and was a member of the former Men's Brotherhood of the church.

He was a member of the Men's Garden Club of New Bremen.

Mr. Headapohl was a farmer and retired from Crown Equipment Corporation of New Bremen. He then undertook the custodial duties at St. Paul United Church of Christ and also at the ABC Center in New Bremen.

He was very active in making the arrangements and various decorations for activities at the New Bremen Public Library.
