### Caroline Boecker

Funeral services for Mrs. Caroline Boecker, aged 68, lifelong and widely-known resident of the Minster community who was claimed by death Monday after an extended illness, have been arranged for Saturday at 9 a. m. in St. Augustine's Catholic church.

Death concluded an illness of eight months' duration, during four months of which Mrs. Boecker was bedfast. Her condition had been critical for some time before the end, which occurred at 3:50 p. m. in her farm residence three miles southeast of Minster.

Born on July 24, 1871 she was a daughter of the late Clemens and Bernadina (Schirmoeller) Heckman, early residents of this community who came from Germany. She was married to Henry Boecker in St. Augustine's church here on June 9, 1891. He preceded her in death on July 4, 1922.

Surviving are two sons and a daughter, namely Bernard, who resided at home with his mother; Raymond, also at home; and Mrs. Clara Schemmel of Minster. There are ten grandchildren.

Two brothers and two sisters are living. They are Clemens Heckman of Cincinnati and John Heckman of Osgood, and Mrs. Mary Bergman of Minster and Mrs. Josephine Berning of east of here. A half sister, Mrs. Ben Leugers, is left.

Mrs. Boecker was a lifelong and faithful member of the Catholic church, and prior to her passing was strengthened by the reception of the last sacraments of her faith. She was a member of the St. Monica society of the St. Augustine parish.

Rev. Vitus Schuette, the pastor, will have charge of the services Saturday morning. Burial will be made in the parish cemetery.
