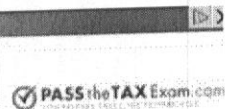

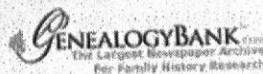

Betty, 55, 6848 Ohio 705, New Weston, died at 8 p.m., at Community Hospital.

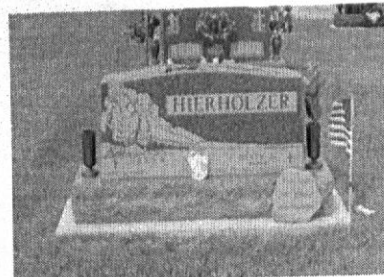

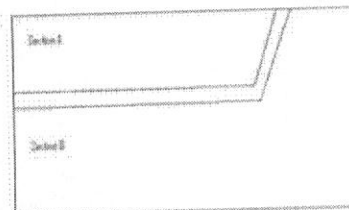
