EDWARD G. HIRSCHFELD

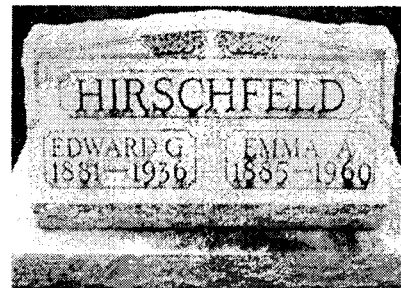
Rev. J. C. Meichert will officiate at the funeral services to be held Sunday afternoon for Edward George Hirschfeld, 55, whose death early yesterday morning followed a brief illness. The services will be conducted at 1:45 o'clock from the late residence on South Herman street and at 2:00 o'clock in St. Paul church. Burial will be had in the German Protestant cemetery.

Mr. Hirschfeld, an employe of the state highway department, became ill last Friday and was bedfast only one day. Born April 22, 1881, on a farm southwest of New Bremen, he was a son of the late William Hirschfeld and Mary (Piehl) Hirschfeld. His marriage to Miss Emma Oberwitte, who survives him, occurred here October 26, 1905.

Besides the widow, Mr. Hirschfeld leaves a son, Verlin Hirschfeld, and a daughter, Miss Viola Hirschfeld, New Bremen. He also is survived by his aged mother, Mrs. Mary Hirschfeld, two brothers, Oscar Hirschfeld and Raymond Hirschfeld, and one sister, Mrs. George Fark, New Bremen.
