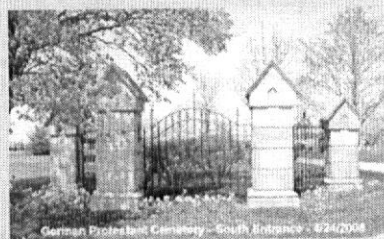

## William Frederick Hirschfeld

William Frederick Hirschfeld was born in German township on April 20, 1853, the son of the late George and Louise (Ortman) Hirschfeld. His youth was spent on the parental farm but upon attaining maturity he came into possession of a farm of his own along the Amsterdam road. He was then united in marriage with Miss Mary Piehl, a union which was blessed with six children, two of whom, however, preceded their father in death. The family continued to reside on the Amsterdam farm until eighteen years ago when Mr. Hirschfeld purchased the present home on South Herman street. He was then employed as caretaker of the grade school building, the present teacherage, for two years but resigned to spend his declining years in complete retirement. He enjoyed the best of health until a little more than a year ago since when he had been bedfast at various times. His death occurred very unexpectedly on last Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock and was caused by cerebral apoplexy. Surviving members of the family include the widow, Mrs. Mary Hirschfeld; three sons, Ed Hirschfeld, Oscar Hirschfeld, and Raymond Hirschfeld; and one daughter, Mrs. George Fark.

Funeral services were conducted at the family home at 1:45 o'clock, Sunday afternoon. Services for the deceased were also read in St. Pauls church at 2 o'clock by Rev. Jno. C. Melchert. Burial occurred at the German Protestant cemetery.
